

Required Registration Instructions: RGGI 9/21/05 Stakeholder Meeting

To better accommodate those who have expressed an interest in attending the September 21 RGGI Stakeholder meeting in Boston, we are moving the event to a larger room at the Boston Convention Center. The Convention Center is located at 415 Summer Street, which is only a few hundred yards from Foley Hoag, where we have met previously.

You can walk to the Convention Center easily from South Station or the World Trade Center stop on the new Silver Line. Self-parking is also available for \$10 and valet parking for \$20. See <http://www.mccahome.com/transportation.html> for directions.

Please note that the Convention Center is huge (something like 11 football fields can fit inside) and we will be in Room 109, which is all the way in the Southwest corner (the main entrance on Summer Street is on the north side). You should keep this in mind when parking, or if being dropped off by taxi.

Since the Convention Center has a food court, everyone can eat there, and we will not be collecting \$15 at the door. We will not be offering breakfast, but we will have coffee, tea, and water available in the morning.

The meeting will still start promptly at 9:00 and we will end by 4.
